



## **NAVPEN ADVISORY**

### **UPLOADING AMENDED PRE-2016 E-PPOs**

1. The first set of e-PPOs for Pre-2016 retirees were generated by PCDA(N). The set consisted of 30,134 e-PPOs and were uploaded on NAVPEN Website on 13 Aug and 20 Aug 2020 for veterans to download a copy. NAVPEN issued an advisory for veterans to seek clarification from PCDA (N), Mumbai on e-mail ID [pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in](mailto:pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in) for any discrepancies observed in the e-PPO. Post uploading of e-PPOs it was brought out that mismatch/ anomaly of data persisted in some cases.
2. In response to emails received on [pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in](mailto:pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in) post uploading of first set of Pre 2016 e-PPOs, PCDA (N) has carried out amendment on first set of e-PPOs. As per PCDA (N) Advisory No. 3 dated 23 Oct 2020, e-PPOs have been regenerated by PCDA (N) post amendment. The list of 732 amended e-PPOs have been uploaded on NAVPEN website at <https://www.indiannavy.nic.in/navpen/list-pre-2016-e-ppos-generated> to facilitate the downloading of e-PPO.
3. Mismatch/ anomaly of data observed by the veteran in e-PPOs are to be notified to PCDA(N) through email ID [pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in](mailto:pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in) along with copies of all concerned Corrigendum PPOs previously issued. As per PCDA (N) Advisory No. 3 dated 23 Oct 2020, PCDA(N) has taken action on all the anomalies notified by veterans along with respective Corrigendum e-PPOs on email ID [pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in](mailto:pcdanavysuomoto.dad@gov.in). However, for addition/ updation of data in e-PPOs where there exists no previous Corrigendum PPO, fresh changes are to be carried out at NAVPEN. 4. Pre-2016 e-PPOs are being generated by PCDA (N) in a phased manner. Hence, veterans who are not in receipt of e-PPOs will be receiving it on a later date.
